The Foundation is completely donor supported. You have requested The Foundation to take ownership and care of the Bird.

Whether prior to its arrival at The Gabriel Foundation or upon placement with The Gabriel Foundation, every bird must undergo a thorough avian wellness exam, the nature of which may vary depending upon the bird's species, age, history or physical findings. This extremely important procedure helps to provide for the safety of your bird as well as the current flock in residence at The Gabriel Foundation. Parrots often mask their illnesses, and though your bird may "act fine" or has "never been sick" diagnostics can help to determine whether or not that is correct according to the best

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current practices in avian medicine. Birds may pass disease through their feces and oral or nasal discharge to other birds. Parrots may carry *Chlamydophila psittaci* or avian tuberculosis that is transmissible to other birds or people.

**TGF's Avian Medical Protocol** is designed to rule out possible indicators of disease. The charges for this testing can vary for an avian wellness exam and diagnostic testing, but average estimates are:

Canary/Finch/Budgerigars/doves, pigeons \$60.00 Cockatiel/Lovebird/small birds \$75.00

Most other parrots \$250.00/\$350.00

You and/or your veterinarian will be provided a copy of The Gabriel Foundation's Avian Medical Requirements prior to admission to The Foundation. We suggest that all costs should be discussed with your veterinarian prior to any testing. This bird has been in your care and you have been responsible for its welfare as its owner. If your bird has never been to a veterinarian with a special interest in avian medicine, TGF will arrange a veterinary wellness exam with one of our attending veterinarians or make a referral. TGF strongly requests that you make a restricted donation for the veterinary/medical intake exam when these services are provided by TGF on behalf of your bird.

To ease your bird's transition into TGF, whenever possible, when your bird is relinquished please provide your bird's cage, dishes and toys along with any of your bird's favorite things.

The Foundation is requested to accept hundreds of birds annually. Due to the cost of medical care, caging, toys, food, flight habitats, staff and the day-to-day business needs of providing for the birds, it is financially impossible to provide high standards of care for resident birds without your financial support for your bird's care at The Gabriel Foundation. Your financial responsibility does not end when your bird is placed with the Foundation.

Program support fees provide for the absolute best in care for your bird(s) while in the care of The Gabriel Foundation. Benefits include:

- Daily hands-on care and interaction, bird-to-bird social interaction, frequent bathing and attention to special-needs birds by highly skilled aviary technicians.
- Nutritious, well balanced diets that include fresh greens, vegetables, fruit, legumes, grains, nuts, seeds, Lafeber's Nutriberries, and other bird food diets as appropriate.
- Indoor & Outdoor habitats (depending on your bird's physical location) with enriched environments, and foraging opportunities.
- Medical services and quality supportive care provided by experienced veterinarians with a special interest in avian medicine, CVT's, TGF's trained staff and AHT's.

The Program Fee Schedule reflects *minimum* financial support for each bird relinquished to The Gabriel Foundation. All program fees and veterinary care reimbursement are tax-deductible for birds in TGF's Sanctuary and Rehabilitation programs. All donations, both cash and non-cash provided for any bird in TGF's sanctuary or rehabilitation programs are tax-deductible and will be acknowledged.

Photos and updates of your bird will be provided upon request to The Gabriel Foundation. We encourage you to email or submit your request online for information about your bird.

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## **Program Fee Schedule**

- 1 Finch or Canary: \$20/month or \$240/year
- 1 small bird Budgie, Lovebird, Cockatiel, Forpus, Dove: \$30/month or \$360/year
- 1 small Conure, small Lory or Quaker, Rosella, Brotegeris, Forpus, or Neophema: \$50/month or \$600/year
- 1 Dwarf Macaw, small Amazon, Pionus, Asiatic Parrot, large Conure, Poicephalus, or Lory: \$60.month or \$720/year
- 1 Amazon, small (RB2, G2, BE2, Citron, Lesser) Cockatoo, Eclectus, Grey Parrot, or small Macaw: \$80/month or \$960/year
- 1 Macaw, large Amazon, large (GSC2, Triton, U2) Cockatoo: \$100/month or \$1200/year
- 1 Hyacinth Macaw, Greenwing Macaw, or Moluccan Cockatoo: \$120/month or \$1440/year

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By signing this Parrot Acquisition Contract (the "Contract"), you transfer ownership of the bird described above (the "Bird") to The Foundation. Your signature confirms that you agree to all the terms of this Contract.

If for any reason the Bird is returned to you, you agree to reimburse The Foundation for all expenses of caring for the Bird, such as veterinary care, food, toys, boarding, and overhead expenses.

You warrant to The Foundation that you are the sole owner of the Bird, have the right to transfer its ownership to The Foundation, and that there are no encumbrances on or other ownership interests to the Bird.

You agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless The Foundation, its agents, directors, officers, employees, volunteers, and affiliates from and against all actions, claims, damages, losses, and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) if any of the above warranties are incorrect or incomplete, or if you breach this Contract.

You agree, without additional consideration, to sign, acknowledge, and deliver any other documents and take any other action necessary or appropriate and reasonably requested by The Foundation to carry out the intent and purposes of this Contract.

Colorado law will govern this Contract, and you agree that any litigation arising under this Contract will be brought in a court having jurisdiction within Colorado. In any dispute, the prevailing party shall recover reasonable attorneys' fees and costs.
